Key Poll Findings


Among the key poll findings are:

- A substantial change in the assessment of President Obama, both as President of the United States and of Obama personally.
- Remarkably stable views on the Arab-Israeli conflict and the prospects of its resolution
- A majority of the Arab public now see a nuclear-armed Iran as being better for the Middle East




How would you describe your views of President Barack Obama of the United States?



How would you describe your attitudes toward the Obama Administration policy in the Middle East?




When you look back at the past year of the Obama Administration, which one of the following policies are you most <u>disappointed</u> with?


What do you believe is the likely outcome if the prospects of a two-state solution in the Palestinian-Israeli conflict collapse?





As you look at the internal Palestinian political divisions, do you prefer to see a:





Do you believe that Iran is merely conducting research for peaceful purposes, or trying to develop nuclear weapons?




Do you believe that Iran is merely conducting research for peaceful purposes, or trying to develop nuclear weapons? (2010)








If Iran acquires nuclear weapons, which of the following is the likely outcome for the Middle East region?








When you watch international news, which of the following network's news broadcasts do you watch most often?


When you watch international news, which of the following network's news broadcasts do you watch most often? (1st & 2nd choices combined)




